

Bleacher Inspection & Maintenance Program

A Dant Clayton inspection satisfies the ***IBC building code ICC 300-2007 section 105.2 which requires the bleachers are inspected on a yearly basis and maintained by manufacture's standards.*** It will also provide documentation which can be submitted to your liability insurance provider that the facility is being maintained in a safe and professional manner. Proper maintenance inspections are a prudent action to protect your occupants and is valued by your insurance carrier.

The inspection checklist will report on all observations made during the inspection and what actions are recommended to ensure the general safety and wellbeing of your occupants. Each bleacher inspected will also be tagged for that year as required by code. We will also provide you with the maintenance required along with the estimated cost of repair of the observed deficiencies.

The scope of items which will be inspected:

- Structural steel- bolted connections and welds
- Concrete and anchor bolts
- Footboards and fasteners
- Risers, seat boards, individual seating and attachment brackets
- Stair and ramp components
- Handrail, NFPA rails and fencing products
- Press box and landings
- Walkways
- ADA seating sections

The scope of items which will be reviewed after or during inspection:

- Any potential safety issues
- Maintenance required
- Significant aesthetic issues
- Upgrades available
- Breakdown of costs associated to supply and ship material with sending qualified technicians to perform work

Once the repairs have been made and your bleacher meets the requirements of your state, we will provide you with an inspection certificate to wall post for that year. This report will give you the peace of mind your bleacher has been inspected for general safety and code compliance. It also meets the yearly inspection requirement of the IBC building code.
